Each year, Long-finned pilot whales are brutally slaughtered on the Faroe Islands, an autonomous province of Denmark. This beautiful species of dolphin was once hunted by the local population for food. Today, the hunt is no longer necessary to feed people. However, the annual hunt has grown into a cultural tradition. During the hunt, men in boats herd groups of pilot whales into a bay, where they are dragged from the water using steel hooks. Each year, hundreds of animals are killed during the hunting season, which usually takes place during the summer.

The Party for the Animals finds it shameful that the government of the Faroe Islands still permits this hunt, which serves no reasonable purpose, and thus calls for everyone to sign the protest mail below.
